

RSYC MINI REGATTA 1st & 2nd July 2017

The Regatta will comprise minimum of 3 races held over 2 days, the regatta winner shall be the yacht with the lowest score over the 3 races. Race Day 1 Pulau Angsa Race shall for single points the Harbour races 50% extra points.

No discard is allowed.

IRC declared handicaps shall be used except where yachts have no IRC handicap in which case local handicap as notified by the Race Committee shall be applied.

Entrance fee for the mini regatta is RM 80/pax which includes buffet dinner on 2nd July.

Farr 25 Platu is available for charter at the rate of RM 400 for member & RM 600 for non-member for 2 days event.



NOTICE OF RACE

Mini Regatta – Day 1 Pulau Angsa Race

Date : SATURDAY 1st July 2017

Event : Mini Regatta (Pulau Angsa)

Time : First warning signal at 1125hrs

Classes : A Keelboat Class and a separate Platu Class will be operated if sufficient boats

register for racing, If not, the Race Committee may decide to combine these

classes.

Unless notified on the day on the Race Notice Board, all classes will sail the same

course and start together.

Start : In the vicinity of TAIL BUOY. Exact position will be given by VHF once the start

boat is in position. The time limit for the start shall be 30 minutes.

Finish : The FINISH will be an imaginary line drawn for 200 metres due magnetic west of

TAIL BUOY.

Finish : Boats shall take their own GPS based finish time as they pass Tail Buoy at a

bearing

Times of 90 degrees off their PORT beam, within 200m of the Buoy.

This finish time shall be sent by SMS to 016 – 333 0441 as soon as

possible after finishing.

All boats shall SMS notification of their safe return to RSYC even if they retire and

do not complete the course.

Time limit : Cut off time for finishing 1830hrs same day.

Race Officer : TBA

Entering : ALL Competitors are required to sign on the list on the Race Notice Board including

number of crew and at least one handphone number.

NOTES:-


1. Working channel is 72 for comms – ALL boats SHALL carry a working (fully charged!) VHF radio.

- 2. All boats shall carry lifejackets for all crew and flares.
- 3. Safety Note: Please keep clear of shipping lanes wherever possible and cross such shipping lanes via the shortest route possible.

1. Courses to be used will be posted on the Race Notice Board. Request for the course book from the Club's office prior to the race.

- 2. Working channel is VHF 72 for comms All boats shall carry a working, fully charged VHF radio.
- 3. SSI is amended as follows (this will also apply to all future Club Races until further notice)
 - START LINE will be between the Signal boat at the starboard end of the line, displaying an ORANGE Flag and either a nearby navigation buoy OR a Yellow OR Orange Dan buoy.
 - FINISH LINE as follows :... (when no flag flown the signal boat is moving position off station)

START AND FINISHES			
ORANGE	SIGNAL BOAT is on station at the START LINE (Starboard End)		
BLUE	SIGNAL BOAT is on the station at the STARBOARD end of the FINISH LINE		
BLUE OVER ORANGE	SIGNAL BOAT is on station at the PORT end of the FINISH LINE
