### NOTICE ON PONTOON USAGE

The Club Committee has decided that the following reminders be made to boat owners using the Club Pontoons, viz:

- [a] due to growing demand and occasional cases of congestion at the Club Pontoons, the Club may have to insist that **boat owners should be limited to berth only one boat each at the Club Pontoon**; this will be supported by improving security and safety at the River Pontoons; and
- [b] the Sultan Pontoon will be kept strictly for the intended purposes of 'receiving incoming boats, visitors, embarking and disembarking of passengers, and daytime washing and preparation', and it should be **kept clear overnight** unless special permission has been granted.

## BOATS FOR SALE

The Club is organising a series of abandoned and indebted boats to be made available for Members who wish to offer a reasonable price for the boat of your choice. The boats will be advertised through the Club's newsletter, Notice Boards and website for a limited period. This first offering will take place from 11 to 25 January, 2021.

The invitation to bid shall be subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

1. The boats will be sold on an 'as-is, where-is' basis.
2. No representations or warranties are given by the Club on the condition, fit for use or safety of the boats.
3. Each bid (*Refer Page 4 for Bid Form.*) must be in a sealed envelope and contain a proper reference to the subject boat, full details of the bidder and be accompanied by a cash or cheque bid deposit of RM300.00 which will be refunded should the bid be unsuccessful.
4. Bids addressed to the Club Treasurer will be accepted at the Club Office during working hours from 9.00 am until 5.00 pm on each day from 11 to 25 January 2021. Bids submitted after 5.00 p.m. on 25 January 2021 will not be accepted
5. Winning bidders must pay up the balance (after deduction of the RM300.00 bid deposit) of their offered price within 2 days, unless extended by mutual consent. Failure to conclude the balance payment will result in a cancellation of the award and a forfeiture of the bid deposit.
6. The Club Committee reserves the right not to accept whatever bids as it deems fit without assigning any reason therefor.

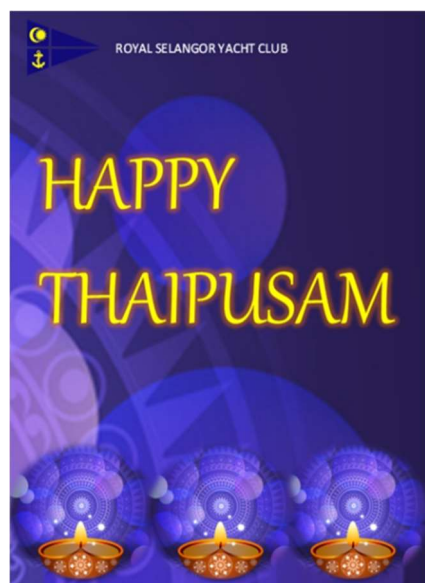
