The meeting was briefed on the status of the current security situation in RSYC by Mr. Jarret. Issues encountered in the performance of their duties were tabled for discussion and addressed with the assistance of the Committee and the Management. Mr. John Rajoo spoke on the crime trend and explained the importance of understanding the nature and sources of crime, detection, prevention and deterrence. A short video was shown to get the message across to the security guards to better understand their roles and responsibilities.
