Ramadhan 1446H, the fasting month for the Muslim Community will begin on 2 March 2025.

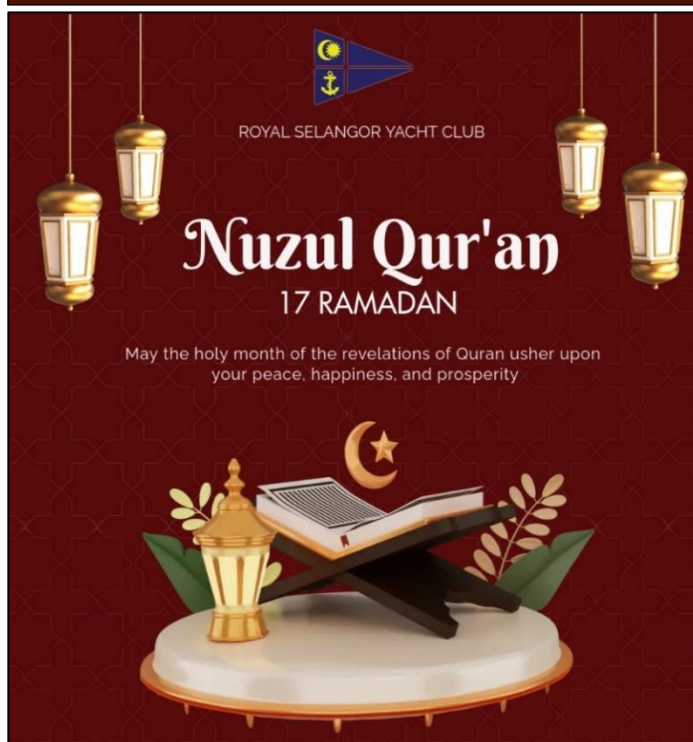
The end of this holy month will be celebrated with the Hari Raya Aidilfitri festival on 31 March and 1 April 2025.

NUZUL AL-QURAN

ISSA YACHT CREW CERTIFICATION

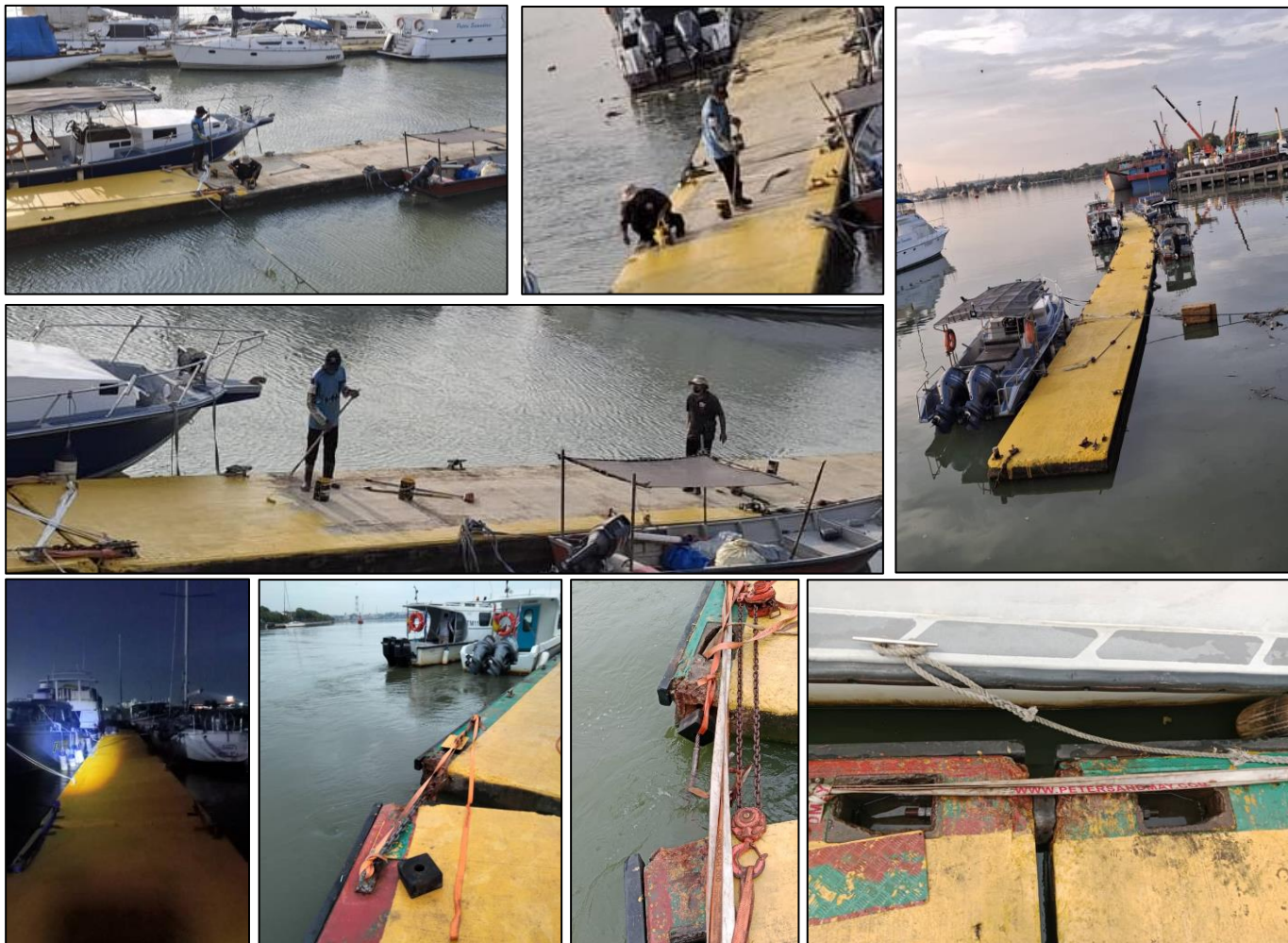
