Westports Sailing Opening Ceremony



On the 14 April 2018, the Royal Selangor Yacht Club (RYSC) officially launched its 4th year RSYC/Westports Community Sailing, which will run from April to December this year. During the opening ceremony, 13 students who completed their 2017 training programme received their certificates from the RSYC Life Commodore Raja Muda Selangor Tengku Amir Shah Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah.

In addition, 10 extra students from SK Pulau Indah 2 will be joining the existing students from SK Pulau Indah 1 and SMK Pulau Indah. They will be given the opportunity to learn sailing at the oldest yacht club in Malaysia. Throughout the programme, the 23 students aged 9 to 16 will be provided with boats, equipment and training as well as classroom sessions for life skills and career guidance. The students will also learn the basics of sailing before progressing to more advanced dinghy racing techniques and eventually participate in races.

The programme head coach Mr. Rizal Mahadi explained that their aim is to give the students more exposure to dinghy racing this year once the new students are able to handle the boats with proper guidance. They also hope to send experienced students to participate in more regattas around the country for better exposure.

Also, present was RSYC Past Commodore, Mr Jeff Harris and Westports Chief Executive Officer, Mr Eddie Lee.

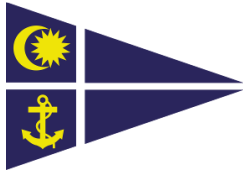

Reminder on Mandatory Insurance of Vessels in Malaysian Water

We would like to highlight on the Insurance of Vessels in Malaysia Water that Third Party Liability (TPL) insurance is mandatory for yachts and vessels under 300GRT, essentially to cover damage and injury caused by vessels to crew, passengers, environment (pollution), government property (navigation marks, wharfs). The limit of the liability is RM 1.6 million.

The Marine Department Malaysia has been actively checking on boats and yacht berthing in Marinas and yacht clubs in Malaysia. We would like to advise our members who own a boat to send email us a copy of your insurance cover to info@rsyc.com.my.

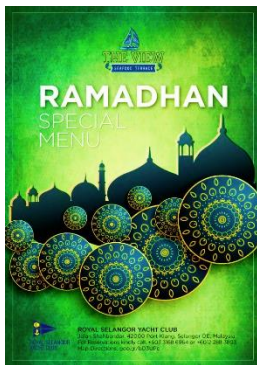
RSYC Keelboat Challenge 2018 Offshore Race
