NEW RFID MEMBERSHIP CARD

The Committee will be launching a new RSYC Membership card which will incorporate RFID chips which will enable its use for car entry to the Club and Members' carparks, entry to Members-only areas and to place orders at the Club restaurant.

The new cards will also carry a coloured photo of the cardholder to facilitate checking and visual verification. For this purpose, the Club will require that Club Members either bring along a coloured pass-port-sized photo or have their photo taken on-the-spot at the Club Office to prepare the new cards.

The new card project will be undergoing a test phase in February and will be targeted to be rolled out in batches beginning in March. The first batch of members targeted will be informed when preliminary tests in February gives the go-ahead for the launch.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTS

The monthly statement of accounts for Club Members will be prepared at the beginning of each following month and the Club has been practising that the statements would be mailed out by post or e-mail or both, depending on Members' preferences
