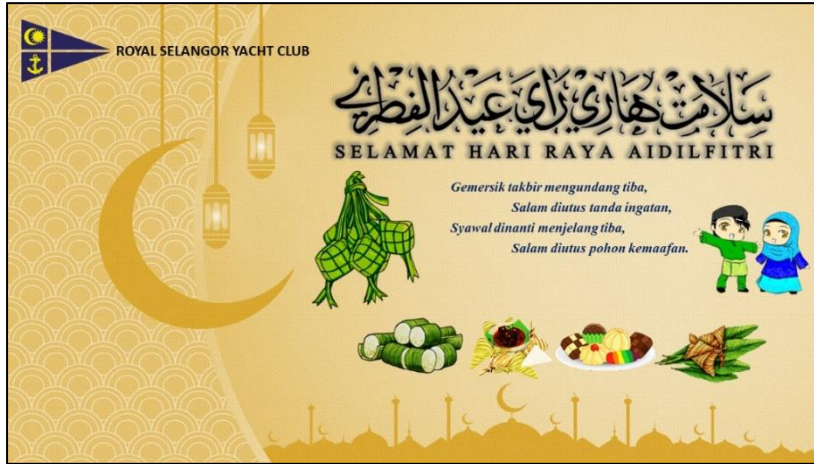

VISIT BY A DELEGATION FROM TONGYEONG CITY, SOUTH KOREA

On Friday, 24 March 2023 a delegation from Tongyeong City, South Korea, made a study visit to RSYC. The visit was arranged by the South Korean LATI (Local Administration Training Institute) Office in KL together with the Club Management.

The delegates consisted of fourteen council members and civil servants from the Tongyeong City Council led by its Chairman, Madam Kim Mi Ok and Vice Chairman, Madam Bae Dosoo, and representatives from the local LATI Office.

The objective of the visit was for the delegation members to learn more about the operations of marinas and yacht clubs. Tongyeong City would be promoting the development of marine leisure and commercial activities on its many islands and long coastline which have been ear-marked by the South Korean government as priority economic activities for investment.

The Club Commodore, Che Wan Mohd Azuar, was accompanied by Vice Commodore, Ramasamy Menon and Committee Members, Irsyad Ismail and Capt. Ananda Kumar, in welcoming the delegation and hosting a fruitful and active dialogue session followed by a breaking of fast dinner at the Club's MAS Terrace.



Tongyeong City is located in Gyeongsang-Bukdo in the south coast of South Korea with a total coastline of 617 km and dotted with hundreds of small islands and historical sites. Besides learning more about the business and operations of marine leisure facilities, the delegation also sought potential partners and investors.

This fun sailing activity will be followed by another two KBCs on 2 and 16 April before the Eid celebration.

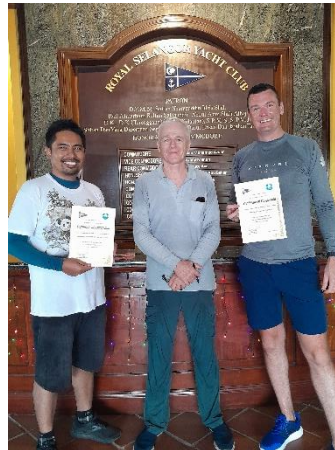

VOLUNTEER FOR BOAT YARD AUDIT

The Office will be organising a team (or two) to conduct an audit of the boats, new and old, big and small, belonging to Members and non- or past-Members, that are in the boat yards in the Club grounds. The Club Committee wishes to invite Club Members to volunteer their time and experience to assist the Office and Yard Teams in this exercise.

The Office has updated its lists of boats stored in the Club's boat yards with the boats' locations, registration numbers and Members' account details. The next phase of the update exercise will be an audit to verify the accuracy of the recorded boat details including its location, physical dimensions (which will determine the storage charges), and the physical condition of the boat, its stand or trailer, etc.

As part of this exercise, there are several old, neglected and or abandoned boats which could benefit from a second look and assessment from volunteer Members' experienced eyes as to the better alternative uses and outcomes that these boats could be considered for. This could either generate some revenue, settle outstanding debts or clear the space for new boats.

TOWNHALL MEETING FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTIONAL RULES (15 APRIL 2023)

With the passage of time and developments in the operations of the Club, there are various aspects of the Constitutional Rules which needed review and updating.
