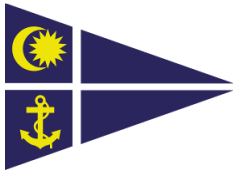
Rules will be 10th July. The deadlines for the nomination forms and “Any Other Matters” will be 17th July.

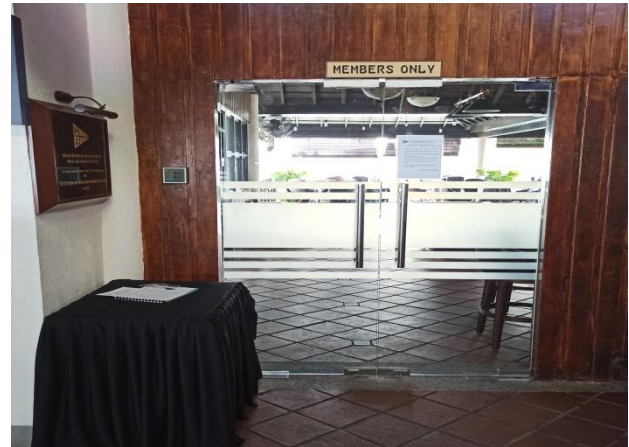

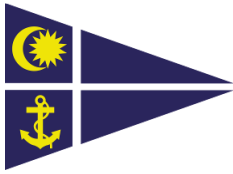


Sailing Program for 2020 will be on Sunday, 5th July 2020 to be followed by the next one, tentatively scheduled for Sunday, 17th July 2020.



Entry to The Sunset Cabin, Members Deck, Members Bar / Magnum Bar Lounge are now restricted w.e.f. 25th June 2020:

1. Please be informed that these are **STRICTLY & EXCLUSIVELY** “MEMBERS ONLY” AREAS. Immediate family members will be allowed entry subject to a reasonable limit and crowd conditions at the time.
2. Sign-in: No Guests / Non-Members are allowed unless signed-in by a Member on the Guest Book.
3. Each Member is only allowed to sign-in a maximum of 2 (Two) Guests to the Sunset Cabin and the non-air-conditioned Members Deck.
4. Dress Code: Collared shirts/t-shirts, long pants and shoes for the air-conditioned areas; smart sailing shorts and footwear may be allowed for the Members Deck.
5. Members are reminded to keep good decorum at all times.
6. Guests and children must always be accompanied by the host Member who shall be personally responsible for their behaviour.



Credit Control: Members are reminded that stringent rules to bar Members (whose accounts are in excess of credit terms or limits) to enjoy the privilege of signing their F&B bills to their credit accounts with the Club. This action is taken on accounts which have debts owing to the Club which *exceeded the credit limit of RMI,500* and or *have been unpaid for 3 months or more*.

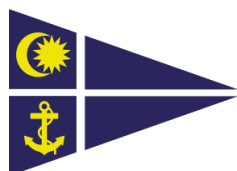
The Club allowed Members whose accounts had been barred to be given a *temporary privilege* to enjoy the members' discount for their new F&B spending provided the Members settled the new bill on cash terms. Such a privilege should morally be used only for a short period of time while the Members take steps to settle their outstanding accounts. From 1st July, Members in default and **who had paid in cash for their new F&B bills multiple times** will run the risk of not being given the privilege anymore until and unless steps had been taken to regularise their accounts, failing which further disciplinary action including suspension could be taken.

Extension of the kiddies' pool:

As reported in the June Newsletter, quite substantial reconstruction work was necessary to repair the damages detected on the structural integrity of the Club's swimming pool decks and their supporting struts and piling. While planning on the possible new layout for this part of the



Clubhouse, suggestions were received from Members and the Committee itself to improve our offering for the younger children in the form of a larger kiddies' pool to cater for more children and their young parents to gather especially on weekend afternoons. The Club hopes that the new pool will be able to accommodate more children of a wider age group, and to revive the popular swimming classes for children as generations before had benefitted from these lessons.



‘RMSIR 2020’ to go ahead with simplified format

The impact of Covid-19 has been felt across the world. Government restrictions put in place to reduce the spread of the virus have impacted many activities, including sporting events. This has led to the cancellation of international sailing races and regattas.

Malaysia has moved to the RMCO phase and more events and gatherings are now permitted, although international travel is still severely restricted and other rules dictate and restrict the way racing can be organised. RSYC committee members and sailors have discussed the issue of running the Raja Muda Selangor International Regatta this year and decided that ‘it’ will go ahead in a simplified form. The most scaled down version will be a series of friendly passage races participated by ‘like-minded’ sailing enthusiasts who are not hampered by travel constraints, ie. all from Malaysia, and the format will be expanded to include more yachts if conditions permit. Limited social gatherings will follow the Government SOPs and this simplified event will require lower than normal expenditure.

RMSIR organisers will stay flexible so that if travel restrictions are lifted then boats from other countries will be included but if a stricter MCO is reintroduced then only fleet sailing will take place. The original scheduled dates of 13th to 21st November, 2020 will not be changed but the format will be modified to include sailing to Pangkor overnight on Saturday 14th November, followed by on the water events in Pangkor on Sunday 15th and Monday 16th November. The Club will encourage power boat owners to come along and join in these activities at Pangkor, further details to be provided later.
