The AGM 2021 which was scheduled to be held on Saturday, 19 June 2021, will be postponed to a date to be announced.

This postponement was due to the MCO 3.0 which did not allow physical meetings to be held and restricted inter-district travel. (And, now, with even further 'total lockdown' restrictions!)

## LOCKDOWN! MCO 3.3 – 1 TO 14 JUNE 2021

1. On 28 May, 2021, the Prime Minister's Office issued a press statement to declare the re-imposition of an MCO 1.0-type of '**total lockdown**' beginning on Tuesday, 1 June, 2021 for a two-week period, ending 14 June, 2021. ***Pending any new SOPs after 29 May, 2021, these are the Club's notifications on changes to its operations.***
2. As such, the operations of the Club will be disrupted and will not be able to receive Members and their guests unless with valid reasons.
3. The Club will maintain essential services such as **24-hour security and pontoon operations**.
4. All visitors to the Club will be required to **register** (via MYSejahtera, SELangkah or manual registration) and have their temperature checked at the Main Gate.
5. Unless prohibited by any new 'lockdown' SOPs, Members and their contractors may continue to be allowed access to their boats for **emergency** inspections and repairs.
6. The Kitchen will be closed until further notice. **NO DINE-IN. NO TAKE-AWAY.**
7. The Club Office will be open from **9.00 am to 5.00 pm** everyday but will provide limited services due to the reduced personnel allowed to be in the office.
8. The Yard and Pontoon operating hours will remain unchanged, from **9.00am to 5.00 pm** daily; should their services be needed outside of these hours (but within permitted MCO operating hours of 8.00 am to 8.00 pm). Please inform the Yard Master, the Office (**03-31686964**) or the Security personnel via the Club Hotline: **012-9721882**.
9. **No recreational boating, sailing or fishing** will be allowed under the current SOPs covering sports and recreational activities. Licenced fishermen may ply their trade in accordance with current SOPs subject to any changes that may be announced.
10. Boat owners who have engaged contractors to work on their boats, are advised to keep them informed of the above, too.
