## COVID-19 MEMBERS AND GUESTS ADVISORY


25 August 2021

Following the recent announcement by the Federal Government on 19 August 2021 to allow dining-in, fishing and other recreational activities for FULLY-VACCINATED Members, family and guests, RSYC will resume the operation of certain Club activities and facilities to them under strict guidelines in accordance with the new SOPs of the National Recovery Plan – Phase 1


**MANDATORY**


- It is mandatory for Members and guests to present their Digital Covid-19 Vaccination Certificates (via MySejahtera, SELangkah or vaccination card or passport) for inspection by security and other authorized Club personnel.
- To be considered fully-vaccinated and qualify to take part in the resumed activities,
  - 14 days must elapse after the second dose for Pfizer, Astra Zeneca and Sinovac vaccinations, or
  - 28 days after a single-dose vaccination like Johnson or CanSino.
- For contact tracing requirements, Members and guests are to scan their entry to RSYC using the MySejahtera or SELangkah apps; those without smartphones must manually record their entry in the logbook provided.
- Face mask must be worn at all times except when dining.
- Only persons whose risk status are low, show no symptoms and normal temperature (below 37.5C) shall be allowed to enter the Club.
- Social distancing must be practiced and gathering or meetings should be avoided.

**SAILING**



Sailing is allowed for **FULLY VACCINATED** members and guests only.

Maximum capacity of 50%

No competitions allowed, only for recreational purpose.


Inshore sailing only.

No inter-district and inter-state travel is allowed.

**OPERATION HOUR: 7AM – 8PM**

- As these activities are highly-regulated and restrictive, Members and guests who partake in these activities do so with their full understanding and regard to their personal responsibilities for their health and safety and their full compliance to the rules, regulations and SOPs as laid down by the authorities.
- To take their boats out, Members and guests must fill the "Undertaking Form" before proceeding with their day's activity.
- No walk-ins. Pre-bookings to be made at least **24-hours in advance** via RSYC hotline Number at **012-972 1882**.

Following the announcement by the Federal Government on 19 August 2021 to allow dining-in, fishing and other recreational activities for FULLY-VACCINATED Members, family and guests, RSYC has resumed the operations of certain Club activities under strict guidelines and in accordance with the new conditions and SOPs of the National Recovery Plan – Phase 1.

The above notice (on Page 1) is an advisory to further explain how these new recreational privileges for those who have been fully-vaccinated have been adopted into practice in RSYC with effect from 27 August, 2021.

Members who wish to take their boats out for recreational activities are requested to pre-book (**RSYC Hotline: 012-972 1882**), at least a day in advance, a time slot for their boat launch and will be required to fill in an ‘Undertaking For Taking Boat Out During NRP Ph 1’.

## RSYC STAFF VACCINATION STATUS

As part of the RSYC preparedness to re-open, all members of the RSYC Team including the office, yard, pontoon, housekeeping and the maintenance staff have been fully-vaccinated except for one pontoon staff who was awaiting for a second dose in early September.

The RSYC Office provided assistance to staff members with their on-line registrations to ensure all the team members would be safe and protected, and ready to work when the Club resumed some Club activities in compliance with the SOPs laid down by the authorities.

The Club wishes to express its gratitude to the Port Klang Authority (or Lembaga Pelabuhan Klang) who had initiated its own vaccination programme for workers in Port Klang at a nominal cost. RSYC signed up to their second programme and had paid for 29 of its staff; these were, however, not needed as the State government’s SELVax programme overtook matters and most residents in the state were promptly vaccinated under this state programme, instead. LPK’s initiative was, therefore, cancelled and the monies paid were refunded.

As at 29-08-2021, nine out of the thirteen contracted security personnel, including RELA, had been fully-vaccinated with the other four awaiting their second shots in September.

The Star Sailors League (SSL) is a new global inshore sailing circuit launched by ex-Olympic athletes in 2013. It was designed to promote sailing athletes and the sport of sailing in an innovative and simple format. Awarded “Special Event” status by World Sailing in October 2017, there are only seven such events and SSL is one of them. (<http://goldcup.starsailors.com/>)



The three main components to the SSL Circuit are SSL Ranking, SSL Final, and SSL Gold Cup. The SSL Gold Cup is set to occur biennially, taking place for the first time with the top 56 Nations of sailing over May and June 2022 in Switzerland. Malaysia (ranked at No. 50) will be one of the participants!



His Highness Tengku Amir Shah Ibni Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah, The Crown Prince of Selangor, is the Patron of the SSL Gold Cup Team Malaysia. The team has been officially nicknamed by His Highness as “The Monsoon.”

For this first edition of the competition, the team will be managed by Megat Danial Megat Najmuddin, an experienced team manager, and also a Member of the RSYC.

RSYC is proud to add that, besides having our Member Megat Danial as the Team Manager, our Club’s experienced Sailing Instructor, Rizal Mahadi (or ‘Tom’ as he is better known in the Club) has been selected as an assistant coach and a member of the SSL Gold Cup Team Malaysia.



In preparation for the first SSL Gold Cup competition in May and June, 2022, groups of participating teams will take part in a 5-days training clinic and a 7-days test regatta at Lake Neuchatel in Grandson, Switzerland. Team Malaysia will join the first group of eight national teams from 6 to 19 September 2021.

Our best wishes from the RSYC to the SSL Gold Cup Team Malaysia and we hope this will increase the profile of competitive sailors and the sport of sailing in Malaysia.
