## 2 DAYS MINI REGATTA



Following the fleet sailing 2 weeks earlier, the Club had organised the annual 2-Days Mini Regatta on the weekend of 23 and 24 October, 2021. Day 1 was a race to Pulau Angsa. The participation was very encouraging. 5 yachts were racing in Class 1 and 4 yachts were racing in Class 2. The entries included participation from several long-absent members which added to the number of yachts in the regatta provided very good competition.

Early morning showers had not affected the pressure that much and the sailors were blessed with very good winds and the sunny weather provided a perfect sailing condition. The mini regatta

was one of the memorable ones considering the pandemic is still prevalent. Most of all, the regatta allowed the sailors to get to the outdoors and breathe the air and return to normal sailing life as much as possible.

Day 2 was racing in the Port Klang Harbour. Heavy rain started very early morning and went on until the afternoon. Sailors were hopeful that there would be some wind left to sail the harbour races. Mother nature was fair. It did give an excellent sailing condition the day before and on Day 2 it gave nature's other creation to enjoy - the much-needed rain! It is simply the balance of life. After all, this is the nature of sailing.

Class 1 was won by Jeff Harris' "Nijinsky". And, Class 2 was won by Ramasamy Menon's VG Offshore. A special token was given to Team "Seven Seas" as an encouragement to the newly joined sailors of the Royal Selangor Yacht Club.

## 31ST RAJA MUDA SELANGOR INTERNATIONAL REGATTA



Planning for the 31st RMSIR is in active progress. Now that Selangor is in Phase 4 of the National Recovery Plan (NRP Phase 4), restrictions on interstate travel have been removed and Langkawi had opened up under the “travel bubble,” the event can go ahead. Currently, only yachts based in Malaysia can participate due to restrictions on international travel, but pending any changes. Most registered entries right now are from local Club members.

We have participation enquiries from skippers from several countries, including famous and long-time regatta supporter, Ray Roberts. Ray keeps one of his TP52 racing yachts in Langkawi, so it may just be possible for him and his crew to fly in to the island, comply with Covid check-in requirements, and then sail down to Port Klang for the start. It is also possible that Singapore travel may open up and boats there can come to join us, although this is a long shot. We are remaining flexible to accommodate last-minute entries.

Our main sponsor, Selangor Tourism, has confirmed their financial support for 2021 and we are very grateful to be working with them once again. Their representatives make a useful contribution to event planning and their senior officials will attend the dinners at RSYC and at the Royal Langkawi Yacht Club and help arrange the cultural entertainment. Penang Global Tourism and the Langkawi Development Authority are also on board and without these levels of support it would be difficult to run the event.

RSYC members are welcome to participate in the opening dinner on Friday, 10 December, tickets will be available from the office, and to view the start from their own boats on Saturday, 11 December. For Members planning to join the Regatta, please make your crew’s hotel bookings early, especially in Langkawi, as this will be a busy holiday period.
