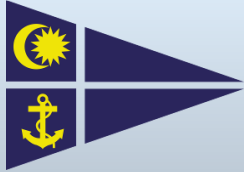

The caterer, nevertheless, persevered to keep the beverages section operating as a service to the remaining clientele at the Club. As at the date of writing, life appears to be returning to the restaurant albeit with a limited menu for the resumption of kitchen operations from 30 March 2022.

SWIMMING POOL SOFT-OPENING



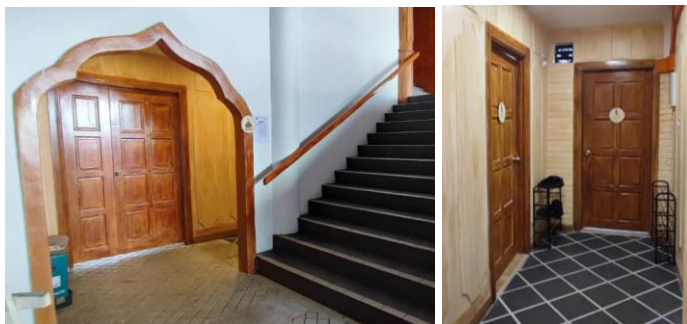

late-March to replace them with new longer-lasting cement boards finished to take on a light brown wooden tone in keeping with the wooden theme of much of the rest of the Clubhouse.

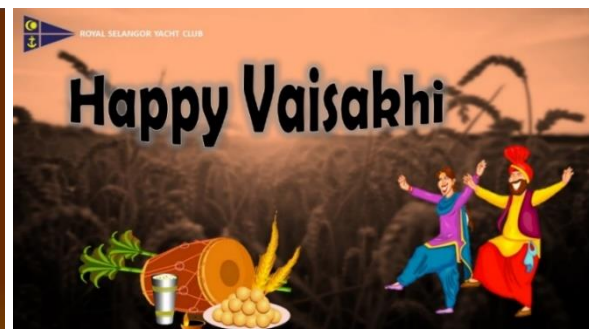
