New Covid-19 SOPs From 1 May 2022

1. Masks are still mandatory indoors including on public transport and e-hailing rides.
2. Masks are optional outdoors but encouraged in crowded places.
3. Masks are recommended to be worn by high-risk individuals.
4. Physical distancing will no longer be compulsory.
5. Physical distancing is encouraged when not wearing a mask.
6. MySejahtera check-in will no longer be required.
7. Entry to premises is allowed regardless of vaccination status except those with 'High Risk', positive cases or still under Quarantine.
8. Individuals should show their risk status on MySJ to premise owners.
9. MySJ users should activate their MySJ Trace function for contact tracing purposes.
10. Covid-19 Positive (Test and Release): the default 7-day quarantine for Covid-19 positive cases will be reduced if a supervised RTK-Ag test on the 4th day turns out negative.
11. Travel to Malaysia: Fully vaccinated travellers and children aged 12 and below are exempted from pre-departure and on-arrival tests. Others must take an RT-PCR test within two-days before departure and a supervised RTK-Ag test within 24 hours of arrival, and undergo quarantine for 5 days. Covid-19 insurance will no longer be required.
12. Negative List will no longer apply and all economic sectors are allowed to operate from 15 May 2022.
