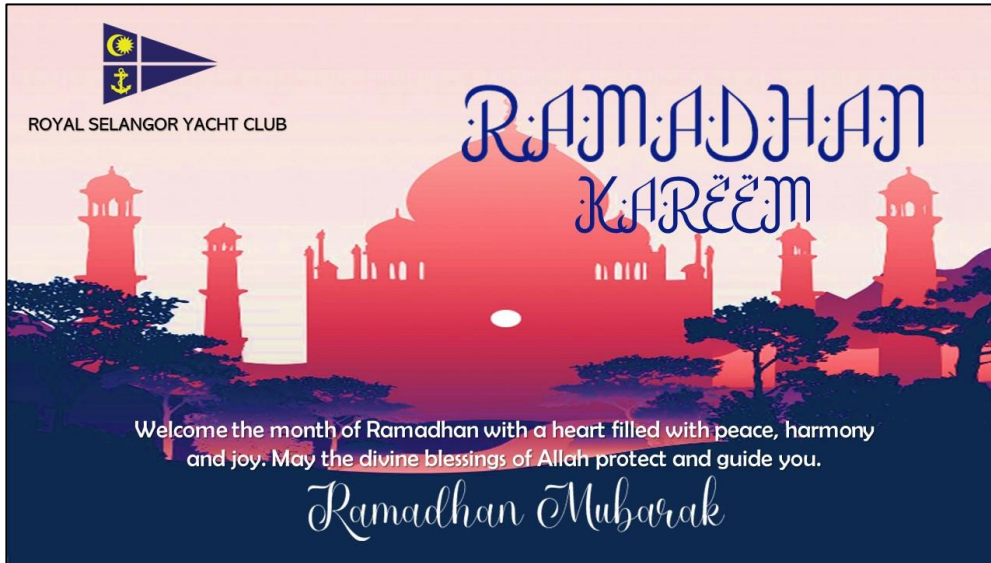

RAMADHAN KAREEM (12 MARCH – 9 APRIL)



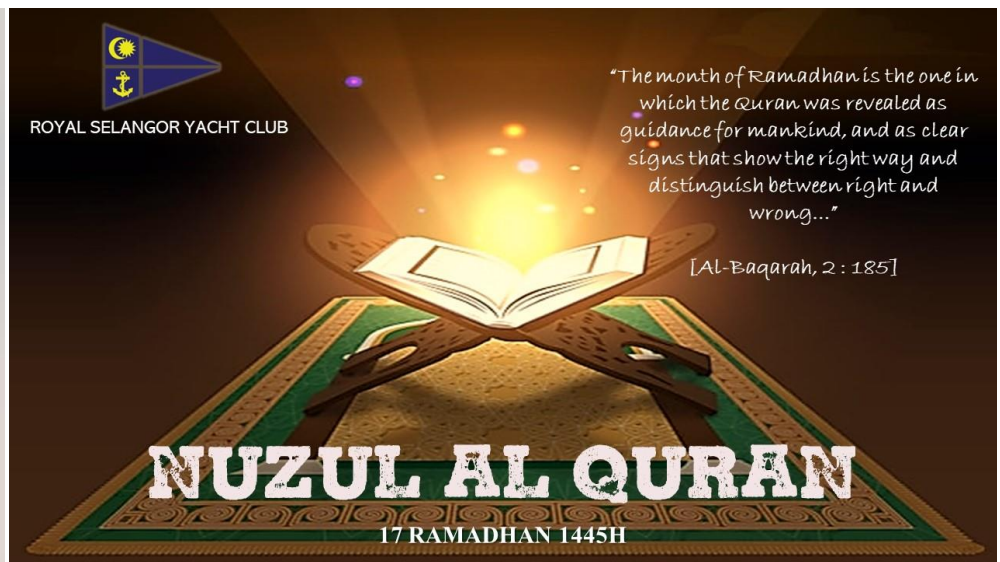
