## UPDATE ON THE ACE TRACTOR



The ACE tractor (Blue Tractor) at the Royal Selangor Yacht Club is out of service due to a corroded clutch plate from sea water exposure. We previously replaced the clutch plate. To

prevent recurring issues, Gulfrich has recommended switching to an organic clutch plate and rust-proofing the housing as a long-term solution.

This replacement will cost RM 3,680. Meanwhile, we are using the Kubota tractor to handle the launching and retrieval of members' boats. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

# HOW TO PREVENT MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES IN AND AROUND YOUR HOME



THE AEDES MOSQUITO CAN TRANSMIT DENGUE, CHIKUNGUNYA AND ZIKA



Change the water in flower vases at least once a week, pouring the used water over the ground



Turn over containers that cannot be thrown away and protect them from rain



Pour out water from pot plants



Cover and seal tanks and water containers to keep out mosquitoes



Keep tyres under shelter, protected from rain



Keep grass short and weed-free



Clean all drains and gutters



Safely dispose of any unused containers and objects that can accumulate water



Avoid mosquito bites during the day by wearing long sleeve clothing or using mosquito repellent



Keep a mosquito coil lit around the house



Pull down tarp over cars or outdoor equipment when not in use



Cover or empty swimming pools when not in use

## A reminder to all members:

Preventing mosquito breeding at the boatyard is vital for everyone's comfort and health. To help minimize mosquito populations, please regularly remove standing water from containers, tarps, and boat covers, as stagnant water is a prime breeding ground. Ensure drains and gutters are clear and in good working order. Using mosquito repellents, like citronella candles or insect traps, can also help deter them around the yard. Consider planting mosquito-repellent plants and using larvicides in water features that cannot be drained. Regular inspections are recommended to stay proactive in mosquito control efforts.
