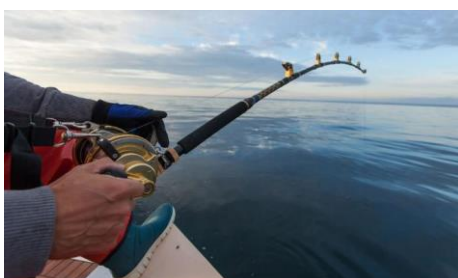
AUDIT OF BOATS BERTHED AT THE CLUB – PONTOON & YARD

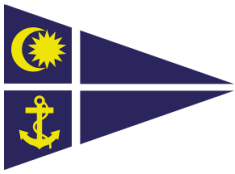
PARKING OF VEHICLES – NEW YARD (NORTH PORT)
